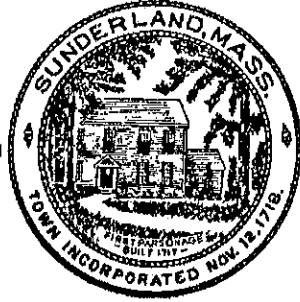

Note to Applicant: The plan submitted for ANR endorsement must be prepared and signed by a licensed surveyor or engineer and must include a representation(s) of lot(s) for which a determination is requested, including, as a minimum, dimensions and road frontage(s), as well as the remainder(s) of any lot(s) from which the said lot(s) is (are) to be separated; representations of the way or ways claimed to provide access to the said lot(s), as delineated in Article II, Section 194.3 of the Subdivision By-law; information demonstrating the viability of access from said way or ways; and an insert (locus) map drawn to suitable scale to show the location of the lot(s) in the Town and the relationship of the lot(s) to access roads and immediately adjacent property. Mylar, if signed by the Planning Board, must be recorded at Registry Deeds.

Cost: \$150.00, plus \$30.00 per lot.
