

## Selectboard Minutes

Monday, December 9, 2019

Attending: D. Pierce, S. Bergeron, T. Fydenkevez

Meeting recorded and televised by FCAT.

Meeting called to order at 6:35PM.

### APPOINTMENTS

- Fire Chief Steve Benjamin appeared before the Board with FIREFIGHTERS JOHN SULLIVAN, TIM GOCHINSKI AND JOSH MANHEIM who are being recognized for COMPLETING FIREFIGHTER ACADEMY TRAINING which is similar to the training the full-time Firefighters attend. Training includes over 200 hours of classroom and training. The Board expressed their appreciation for their dedication and said the town is proud of their community commitment.
- The Fire Chief gave an update on the new FIRE TRUCK after visiting the manufacturer recently. Truck delivery is expected around Christmas.
- Lorin Starr representing the VILLAGE CENTER COMMITTEE came before the board to give an update on the Committee's areas review of opportunities in town. The focus has changed to include N. Main St., School St. and the intersection. Maureen Mulvaney noted a meeting with MassDOT should be arranged sooner rather than later with recommendations or questions. The focus on School Street requires 50% design finalization for MassWorks grant. Recommends a joint Selectboard / Village Center Committee with neighbors be held as soon as possible. Selectboard scheduled meeting for 12/16/19 at 7PM to include special invitation to the School Street residents.

### PUBLIC COMMENT

- Sara Snyder announced the next CPA GRANT CYCLE IS OPEN. Applications are due 01/31/2019. Updated information is on the website.
- Discussion regarding gate at the Boat Ramp being closed in the evenings and winter months. Area is responsibility of the state.

- Mr. Pierce announced a Union 38 proposal was made.

- Mr. Bergeron attended Frontier Capital Planning Sub-Committee which is advisory to the School Committee. FRCOG will do bid/purchasing process and will act in an advisory role for the Frontier track work.
