928 positive tests (25.3 percent of population) since beginning of pandemic, not including suspect cases or at-home tests


3.5 percent of those infected have been reinfected at least once more


Average age of cases: 32.6 years old

Average age of those who died from COVID: 76 years old












Red columns are clusters within a community.


Green and yellow columns are clusters outside a community but involving a local resident.

Average absences are by number, the other categories are percent of student population




